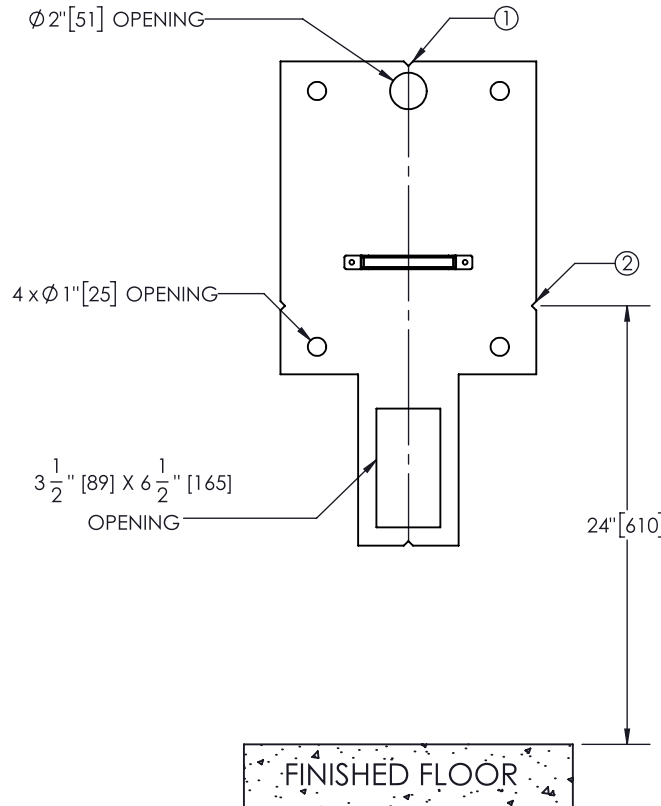


# 14" Washdown Urinal Wall Template

## Submittal & Installation

### 102835



\*Material is 18GA galvanized steel

TEMPLATES ARE USED TO OUTLINE THE REQUIRED WALL OPENINGS FOR SUBSEQUENT FLAME CUTTING OR CORE DRILLING.

A. SCRIBE A HORIZONTAL CHALK LINES (2) ON THE WALL AT THE "NOTCH" DIMENSION SHOWN, MEASURE FROM THE FINISHED FLOOR ON CELL SIDE. THIS WILL LOCATE THE CENTERLINE FOR THE HORIZONTAL NOTCHES ON THE TEMPLATES.

B. SCRIBE A VERTICAL CHALK LINE (1) ON THE WALL TO INDICATE THE CENTERLINE OF THE FIXTURE. THIS WILL LOCATE CENTERLINE FOR THE VERTICAL NOTCHES ON TEMPLATE.

C. PLACE THE TEMPLATE AGAINST THE WALL. LOCATE NOTCHES ALONG THE CHALK LINES. MARK THE WALL FOR REQUIRED OPENINGS.
